**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN  
CENTRAL IOWA TELEVISION AND THE CITY OF TEMPLETON FOR  
SANITARY/STORM SEWER CLEANING, INSPECTION, AND REPAIRS.**

**WHEREAS**, the proposed project includes cleaning and televising approximately 5000 feet of 8" field tile; and

**WHEREAS**, the work to be done under this contract includes all labor, materials, and equipment for sanitary/storm sewer cleaning, inspection or repaired; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has given due deliberation and consideration to the terms and conditions as stated in the contract; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that it is in the best interest of the City of Templeton to enter into a Sanitary/Storm Sewer Maintenance Contract with Central Iowa Televising and the city of Templeton. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all appropriate documents to effectuate the Contract and this Resolution.
