SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 16, 2020
7:00 P.M. TEMPLETON CITY HALL

The Templeton City Council met on this sixteenth day of April 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, Templeton, Iowa. Social distancing of at least 6 feet apart and no more than 10 people was implemented Meeting was called to order by Mayor Behrens, and the roll was called showing the following named Council Members present and absent:

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Engelen, second by Ramsey to approve the agenda. All present voted in favor of the motion and the motion was carried.

Citizen Forum: None

Mayor Behrens updated council regarding his meeting on April 14, 2020, with Carroll County Supervisor Eugene Meiners, Carroll County Engineer Zac Andersen, Paul Heuton, Darren Dea, Public Works Director Dale Prebeck, and Landus Cooperative representatives Josh Riesberg & Jay Sturtz to discuss proposed Railway Street project.

Proposed Railway Street project:

- Current pavement surface will be milled or grinded away. Resurfacing with 1 ½" asphalt overlay. Project cost - expense of Carroll County.
- Installation of two (2) intakes plus 120' of 10" SDR 35 PVC pipe South of Landus Cooperative. Concrete to encase intakes and support cast iron grates with rebar. Project cost - expense of Landus Cooperative.
- Installation of approximately 327' of 10" Dual Wall on West side of 3rd Avenue between 1st and 2nd Street with 24" Nyloplast storm sewer basin just South of curb on South side of 1st Street. Project cost - expense of the city of Templeton.
- Installation of 100' of 10" SDR 35 PVC pipe from the corner of 1st Street & 3rd Avenue going North to Landus property. Nyloplast storm sewer basin in right of way. Project cost - expense of the city of Templeton.
- Installation of 194 linear feet of 24" curb & gutter West of 4th Avenue on Railway Street. Installation of 200 linear feet of curb & gutter East of 4th Avenue on Railway Street. Removal of old concrete radius and pour new concrete to match existing curb and gutter with new curb and gutter on East side of 4th Avenue. Tie old sidewalk into curb. Installation of 60 linear feet of curb & gutter on the corner of 2nd Avenue and Railway Street. 2,040 square feet of street poured 8" thick with #4 rebar 18" on center at the corner of 2nd Avenue and Railway Street. Project cost - expense of the city of Templeton.
- Install storm sewer intake on the West end of curb & gutter in front of 528 Railway Street. Project cost - expense of the city of Templeton.

A motion was made by Ramsey to proceed with Railway Street project as proposed, second by Bauer. All present voted in favor of the motion and the motion was carried.

At 7:54 o'clock p.m. and with no further business before the council at that time, they agreed to adjourn. Engelen moved to adjourn and Bauer second the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.
