The Templeton City Council met on this twenty-fifth day of June 2018 at 7:00 o'clock p.m. at City Hall, Templeton, Iowa. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Behrens, and the roll was called showing the following named Council Members present and absent:

Council considered bid proposals for garbage hauling and recycling from SGS LLC DBA Carroll Refuse Service and Ray's Refuse, Inc. **RESOLUTION AWARDING AND APPROVING RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TEMPLETON, TEMPLETON, IOWA AND RAY'S REFUSE, INC., CARROLL, IOWA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Templeton City Council interviewed and considered bids for residential solid waste and recyclables collection; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has given due deliberation and consideration to the interviews and bids.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that it is in the best interest of the City of Templeton to enter into a 5-year contract with Ray's Refuse, Inc., Carroll, Iowa at \$11.95 per month per household from October 1, 2018 through October 1, 2023. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract and to award the contract to Ray's Refuse, Inc. Said Bid is Hereby Approved and Awarded on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2018 and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all appropriate documents to effectuate this Resolution.

Council reviewed revised water purchase contract between West Central Iowa Rural Water and the city of Templeton. Tabled.
