## TEMPLETON CITY COUNCIL JULY 6, 2015 7:00 P.M. – TEMPLETON CITY HALL

The Templeton City Council met on this sixth day of July 2015 at 7:00 o'clock p.m. at City Hall, Templeton, Iowa. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Behrens, and the roll was called showing the following named Council Members present and absent:

Approval of Agenda: A motion was made by Wieland and seconded by Ramsey to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Gary Irlbeck and Carol Schoeppner addressed the council concerning water runoff onto Carol's property from North Ridge Addition from possible broken county tile line. Council recommended Mayor Behrens contact Carroll County Engineer Dave Paulson for location of tile and discuss repairing.

City Attorney Robert Peters updated the council regarding his conversation with Attorney Eric Neu about the city of Templeton's interest in an option to buy additional property from the B.J. Conklin Testamentary Trust. No further action taken.

Council acknowledged receipt of application for voluntary annexation of property from Keith & Michele Sporrer and David H. Sporrer Living Revocable Trust for annexation of property described as NW ¼ NW ¼ Section 16-82-35. A motion was made by Bauer accepting the application for voluntary annexation, seconded by Wieland. All present voted in favor of motion and motion carried.

A motion was made by Wieland directing City Clerk to take appropriate action to provide the proper notices to all parties involved to continue annexation process, seconded by Bauer. All present voted in favor of motion and motion carried.

Council reviewed the application for voluntary annexation of property owned by the city of Templeton described as Lot 1 & 2 of the Irregular Survey of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ Section 17-82-35 (North Ridge Addition). A motion was made by Ramsey accepting the application for voluntary annexation, seconded by Wieland. All present voted in favor of motion and motion carried.

A motion was made by Wieland directing City Clerk to take appropriate action to provide the proper notices to all parties involved to continue annexation process, seconded by Ramsey. All present voted in favor of motion and motion carried.

Mike Semke from Semke & Associates presented preliminary plat for development of residential lots in North Ridge Addition. City Attorney Robert Peters reviewed procedures with council for subdivision regulations as per the city of Templeton's Code of Ordinances.

A motion was made by Bauer to appoint Lindsey Irlbeck to the Planning & Zoning Board, seconded by Ramsey. All present voted in favor of motion and motion carried.

City Attorney Robert Peters updated the council regarding the following:

- 2. Memorandum of Understanding between the city of Templeton and Leah Davis, Trustee of the B.J. Conklin Testamentary Trust agreeing to the removal of the grain bin currently located on the property until the last day of July 2015.
